Animals must be entered correctly in line with the rules, detailed in the WPCS Judging and Showing Handbook which can be found on the Society website www.wpcs.uk.com or requested from the WPCS office. Failure to comply with the rules may result in the withholding of awards.

Affiliated to the National Pony Society –

Welsh and PB Welsh Inhand NPS Qualifying Rounds, Breed Show Rules: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breeds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th – 8th August 2024

The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show

All Other NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part breeds are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6th – 8th August 2024.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final.

Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. The Organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, accident or injury to Person, Animal or property.
2. The Judge's decision is final. All objections must be lodged in writing to the Secretary, within half an hour of a class. A deposit of £25 must accompany the objection and will be forfeit if the objection is not upheld.
3. All equines in medal classes must be registered with the WPCS- except foals unless they are 6 months old.
4. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate classes if less than three entries are received.
5. No entry fee's will be refunded or swapped to another show/membership under any circumstances.
6. All foals at foot must be over three weeks old. All weaned foals must be 5 months old or over.
7. Exhibitors must check and follow the stated rules on impartiality for their class as to whether they can exhibit under the judge on the day of the show.
8. All trophies and cups remain the property of the Association and must be returned in good condition and in good time for the next year's show.
9. Whips and Canes No shaft of any whip or cane shall exceed 75cms (30 inches).
10. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to present their exhibit at the ring on time for their class, not the responsibility of the announcer.
11. A brood mare is a mare that has produced a foal, live or dead (vets certificate required) in the current year, all other mares are classed as barren.
12. Ridden Welsh Classes are run under WP&CS Rules unless otherwise stated.
13. All Ridden Equines must be 4 years old or over.
14. Animals, 3 years old and under including foals must not be body clipped for showing purposes. Long hair under the jawline and those protruding from the ears may be trimmed off leaving as natural a line as possible. The whiskers around the muzzle **MUST NOT** be trimmed.
15. All colts/stallion 2yr and over must be bitted and lead by a handler that is 14 or over on the 1st of January in the current year
16. All handlers under the age of 14 must wear a British Standard Hard Hat, gloves and suitable footwear.
17. Riders of stallions 13.2hh and under must be 12 years old as of 1st January and riders of stallions over 13.2hh must be 14 years of age as of the 1st of January.
18. Entry fees will not be refunded without a Veterinary Certificate
19. If the show is cancelled all entry fees will be returned unless the show is rescheduled then no fee's will be returned.
20. The committee reserve the right to ask a competitor to leave the ring if he/she is seen to be showing cruelty or abuse to their animal.
