**Welsh and PB Welsh Inhand NPS Qualifying Rounds, Breed Show Rules:** These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed shows ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 3rd – 5th August 2021.

The highest placed pony, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show

**All Other NPS Qualifying Rounds:** These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 3rd – 5th August 2021.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final.

Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

### **Horse of the Year Show The Price Family Supreme In Hand Semi Final Qualifier**

The following class is a qualifier for the Price Family Supreme In-Hand qualifier at Stoneleigh Horse Show, 3rd-5th September 2021. The Supreme In-Hand Qualifier held at Stoneleigh Horse Show will offer two qualifying places for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, 6th–10th October 2021. The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses).

The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete in the Supreme In-Hand Semi Final, provided it has not already won a Supreme In-Hand qualifier in 2021.

**• Welsh Section A Champion, Welsh Section B Champion, Welsh Section C Champion, Welsh Section D Champion, Welsh Part-bred Champion, NPS M&M In hand Champion, NPS Home-produced M&M In hand Champion, NPS Show Pony Champion, NPS Show Hunter Pony Champion.**

If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2021 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion may come forward to Stoneleigh, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2021 or are ineligible then the Semi-Final will not be represented at Stoneleigh. Foal champions and geldings four years old and over are not eligible to compete or eligible to qualify for Horse of the Year Show.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the Semi Final qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the 2nd and any subsequent sections.

All classes are open to Yearlings, 2 year olds, 3 year olds, Stallions, broodmares and barren mares only. Broodmares must be with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy. Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter with a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year.

There will be no direct entry into The Price Family Supreme In-Hand Championship Semi Final, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable).

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

1. The Organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, accident, injury or disease to Person, Animal or property.
2. The Judges decision is final. All objections must lodged in writing to the Secretary, within half an hour of a class. A deposit of £25 must accompany the objection and will be forfeit if the objection is not upheld.
3. All equines in medal classes must be registered with the W.P.C.S.- except foals unless they are 6 months old.
4. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate classes if less than three entries are received.
5. Brood Mares, Stallions and ridden Equines must be four years or over.
6. All foals must be three weeks old or over on the day of the show.
7. Exhibitors are not allowed to show any equine under a Judge who has owned, bred, or had any financial interest in, or produced for gain, the said animal.
8. Disease – Any animal showing signs of disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately.
9. All trophies and cups remain the property of the Association and must be returned in good condition and in good time for the next years show.
10. Whips and Canes No shaft of any whip or cane shall exceed 75cms (30 inches).
11. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to present their exhibit at the ring on time for their class, not the responsibility of the announcer.
12. A brood mare is a mare that has produced a foal, live or dead (vets certificate required) in the current year, all other mares are classed as barren.
13. Ridden Welsh Classes are run under WP&CS Rules **Novices** -: A Pony/Cob/Welsh Part-Bred shall be deemed to be a Novice if, by 1st January of the current year, it has not won an Open class within the discipline in which it is currently competing. All Novice ridden animals must be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle.
14. Animals, 3 years old and under including foals must not be body clipped for showing purposes. Long hair under the jawline and those protruding from the ears may be trimmed off leaving as natural a line as possible. The whiskers around the muzzle may be trimmed.
15. All colts/stallion 2yr and over must be bitted and lead by a handler that is 14 or over on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year.
16. All handlers under the age of 14 must wear a British Standard Hard Hat, gloves and suitable footwear.
17. Riders of stallions 13.2hh and under must be 12 years old as of 1<sup>st</sup> January and riders of stallions over 13.2hh must be 14 years of age as of the 1<sup>st</sup> of January.
18. Entry fee's will not be refunded without a Veterinary Certificate.
19. If the show is cancelled all entry fee's will be returned unless the show is rescheduled then no fee's will be returned.
20. The committee reserve the right to ask a competitor to leave the ring if he/she is seen to be showing cruelty or abuse to their animal.
21. No bags or other forms of noise aids are not to be used around the rings, please have respect for other competitors
